## *Learning Awards*

The Bulkley Valley Community Foundation (BVCF) manages permanent endowment funds and uses the income generated to enhance the quality of life in our communities. Each year a portion of the income is offered to students so that they can reach their educational goals.

### Frequently Asked Questions

**Q. What awards am I eligible for?**

A. Check our website, [www.bvcf.ca](http://www.bvcf.ca) for complete eligibility and application information.

**Q. When is the application deadline?**

A. Applications must be received by **May 15** each year. Incomplete or late applications may not be reviewed unless there are extenuating circumstances approved by the Board.

**Q. How will I know if I am successful?**

A. You will receive a letter at your graduation ceremony or by mail or email. If you are already out of school and applying for a Fritz Pfeiffer Adult Learning Award, you will receive a letter from us in June.

**Q. When will I receive the funds?**

A. Once we have received written confirmation of registration OR the official receipt of tuition fees from you we will send your award funds.

**Q. Can I use the award next year?**

A. Yes. You have **18 months** to claim your award.

**Q. Do I need to pay tax on my award?**

A. In certain situations, scholarship funds are considered taxable income. An income tax form will be mailed to you. For questions about how this scholarship might impact you, please check with a tax professional, or the Canada Revenue Agency.

**Q. What is the BVCF area?**

A. The BVCF area extends from Topley to Kitwanga, B.C. including Granisle, Houston, Telkwa, Smithers, and the Hazeltons and Upper Skeena regions.
